<p>KNOWLEDGE</p>	<p>UV21582 – Hair and beauty science This unit will provide learners with an understanding of the chemistry of hair and beauty products, including the ingredients in hair and beauty products and their effects on the skin and hair. Learners will develop knowledge of skin and hair anatomy, as well as the characteristics of, and factors affecting different hair and skin types. Learners will define a formulation for a cosmetic hair and beauty product in order to produce enhancing effects on the skin and hair. They will describe the ingredients and substances used and justify their product's formulation.</p>

Learners will be able to respond to a hair and beauty design brief by gathering information using a range of sources, analysing information and developing design ideas. Learners will be able to present their design ideas using a range of materials, media and components and accessories; they will also be able to create a look and feel to their presentation which appeals to the client and meets the design brief.</p>
